Abstract Submission guidelines of PUDUCON'22

The organizing committee of PUDUCON'22 wholeheartedly invites the participation of Anatomy faculties, leading biomedical scientists, research scholars, postgraduates and undergraduates in the domain of Anatomy from Tamilnadu, Pondicherry and other parts of South India to submit original research contributions relating to all aspects of Human Anatomy as follows:

- Category 1 : Gross Anatomy, Surgical anatomy, Anatomical variations & Applied Anatomy
- Category 2 : Histology, Immunohistochemistry & Histomorphometry, Cellular and molecular anatomy
- Category 3 : Cytogenetics, Embryology, Teratology, Growth & Development and Evolutionary Anatomy
- Category 4 : Neuroanatomy, Radiological and sectional anatomy
- Category 5 : Osteology, Anthropometry, Forensic Anatomy, Anatomy of aging Biomechanics and musculoskeletal anatomy Evolutionary anatomy
- Category 6 : Anatomy education and training Anatomical Techniques (Museum & Embalming) Body donation and procurement Ethics and anatomy Digital anatomy and Augmented reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR) in anatomy

*Follow the above-said category names and mention the same while submitting the paper

GUIDELINES FOR ORAL AND POSTER PRESENTATION

Abstract preparation and submission:

The Title should be in **bold**, font type-Times New Roman & font size 14. The first letter of each word should be in the capital.

The Author's name should be mentioned as surname followed by initials, bold Times New Roman, font size 12. The presenter's name should be underlined.

Institution's name should be in Times New Roman, font size 11. If the authors are from different institutions, the number superscript can be marked to distinguish.

*Mention the category name under which the paper is submitted

The main text of the abstract and Biography should be in Times New Roman font size 12, with single spacing. The abstract should be computer typed in Microsoft Word format (*.doc)

For Original articles, the abstract should be structured under the following headings Background, Objective, Method, Result, Discussion and conclusion.

Abstracts submitted in the above-said format only will be considered for presentation.

Maximum word limit-250 words, including figures and tables.

For Case reports, the abstract should be structured under the following headings

Introduction, Case report, Discussion and conclusion.

Maximum word limit-250 words.

Note: Case reports will be considered only for Poster presentation.

Keywords should be included below the main text of abstract in Times New Roman font size 12 and italic.

Follow **Vancouver style** for the references.

One Anatomy faculty and one PG will be awarded the prestigious Dr.M M. Cooper and Dr. Jayavelu memorial Award for the best paper presentation. Anatomy Faculties and Postgraduates who wish to consider their original research articles for award session, should mention that in the form for submitting the scientific paper. (Case reports will not be considered for these awards.)

From each category of papers one of the best presentation among the undergraduates will be awarded “Best Paper Award”

Last date for submission of abstract is October 1st 2022. Acceptance/ rejection of abstract will be intimated by 10th October 2022.

Guidelines for Oral & Poster presentation

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

Those who wish to present the research papers are required to submit an abstract of their oral presentation via the Abstract Online Submission Form, on or before 1st October 2022. Those who are not a member of the Tami Nadu association of anatomist should pay 300/- rupees as annual membership fee.

Organization of Oral Sessions

Each scientific session is scheduled as a one-hour session.

At each session, a faculty moderator will introduce the presenter and keep a track of the scheduled presentation. Three faculty judges will be evaluating the presentations at each session.

There will be four parallel sessions for undergraduates (two each in the first & second-floor lecture halls of the college building) and those who are presenting more than one paper should check the timing of each presentation in advance to avoid conflicts. The Program Committee will try to minimize conflicts of topics between parallel sessions.

Each oral presentation hall is equipped with a computer, LCD projector, and a microphone for your oral presentation. Lecture hall computers are equipped with Windows 10 as well as Microsoft PowerPoint 2019 and Adobe Acrobat Reader DC.

Those who prepare the presentations in Apple's "Keynote" presentation software, please save your presentation in PDF format. Mac Users working in PowerPoint are advised to use True-Type fonts whenever possible to avoid formatting issues when viewing on a PC.

Please note that Internet access will not be available during your presentation.

During each session, a presenter will have 07 minutes to present, followed by three minutes for questions and discussions from the audience and judges.

Guidelines for Oral Presentations:

All the presenting authors are requested to report to the Oral presentation hall at least 15 minutes prior to the session, transfer the presentation to the desktop computer, and verify their presentation for compatibility and proper operation.

Since the total time allotted to each speaker is 10 minutes, you should plan to speak for 07 minutes and leave 03 minutes for discussions/questions.

A good rule of thumb is that it takes an average time of one minute to present one slide, so it is advised that the number of PowerPoint presentation slides should not be more than ten, including the title and final slide.

Practice your presentation in advance so that you know it will be within the 10-minute mark.

Technical instructions for PowerPoint Presentations

Make sure your PowerPoint presentation is in 16:9 ratio (Widescreen).

Videos must be embedded in PowerPoint.

Do not use links to YouTube or other web services in your presentations.

If you used fonts that are not included in the Windows 10 system, you should bring such fonts in flash drive and load the same to the lecture hall computer ahead of your presentation.

Use special effects sparingly. Use animations, cool transition effects, sounds, other special effects, etc., only when they are necessary to make a point.

For the safer side, you should have a backup copy of your presentation materials on your laptop/flash drive/ e-mail and you should bring your own Laser pointer.

Instructions to prepare & display the Posters (for Faculty, PG & UG)

- The poster presentation area is located in the atrium (central open area) of the first floor of the college building.
- One poster board is allocated to each presentation. Those who participate in the Poster presentation should display their Posters around 8.00am in the specified slot.
- Each poster should be displayed for a full day (8:00 am to 4:00 pm). The posters can be removed after 4.00pm.
- The presenting author should be available during the entire poster session (9.30 to 11am) for answering the queries of the audience. Judges will be evaluating the posters from 10 am to 11 am.
- The recommended poster size is 3x4feet i.e **Landscape format** of 36 inches high by 48 inches wide (92 cm x 122 cm)



Posters must be mounted using push pins provided by the organizing committee. All text must be easily readable from a distance of 1 to 2 meters. The title of your poster should be done in block letters which are AT LEAST 80 to 100pt., subheadings 48pt., and body text at least 24pt (small letters won't be legible from a distance of 1 to 2 meters). All graphs and charts should be AT LEAST 25 X 30 cm (approximately 8.5 x 11 inches) or larger.

Instruction for UG students who participate in Competitions

Quiz competition

- 2 teams per college & 3 students in one team
- According to the number of teams, there will be a preliminary evaluating round to reduce the number of teams for the final round.

Body painting competition

- Limited to Face, Neck, upper limb & lower limb
- 3 students including the model
- Participants should explain the painting to the judges during the evaluation

Model-making competition

- Internal organs & Embryology models
- 2 students only allowed
- Participants can choose any material of their choice. Bring the materials for the preparation and make the models within the specified time
- Participants should explain the models to the audience and the judges
