Hospital admissions for heart failure are predicted to rise substantially over the next decade placing pressure on the health care system leading to an increase in health care cost. Globally the burdening of heart failure is escalating with over 2.3 million people worldwide are diagnosed with heart failure. The life time risk of developing heart failure is also high ranging from 30 to 42 % in males and 32 to 39% in females. The majority of these patients will experience not only but several hospitalization is for acute heart failure over their life time. The current global prevalence of heart failure is 64.34 million cases accounting for 9.91 years lost due to disability.

Management of heart failure has been a challenge to health care providers which is reflected by higher rate of re-admissions along with increased mortality and morbidity. The Nurse Led Heart Failure Management Programme will address the issues arising out of the scarcity for specialist in cardiology and prevent unnecessary wastage of the specialist time which much needed for the other conditions that demands life saving measures.
