
In continuation of this Ministry's letter of intent of even number dated 20<sup>th</sup> March, 2006 and with reference to your letter dated 24<sup>th</sup> March 2006, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government to the establishment of a new medical college in the name and style of "Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences" at Pondicherry by Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai with an annual intake of 150 (one hundred and fifty only) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2006-07 under Section 10 (A) of IMC Act, 1956 as amended.

2. This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of the college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

3. This permission is subject to the Bank Guarantee of Rs. 9.50 crores (Rupees 2.00 crores towards medical college and 7.50 crores towards hospital facilities) furnished by Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai for the establishment of medical college and hospital found to be adequate/genuine on all counts. The admission process for the academic year 2006-07 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended.



10. Full justification for opening of the proposed college.	To provide Medical Education facilities for the meritorious students of the Union Territory of Pondicherry and to fulfil the felt needs of the Pondicherry citizen. To sustain the availability of above medical seats for meritorious students of this UT. The Number of available seats are limited to 120 by JIPMER (20) and 2 Private Medical Colleges (50+50) as the other 2 private Medical Colleges have come under the Deemed University and have shown inability to earmark seats for students of Pondicherry. The students from two private Medical Colleges return back to their native States or other places. The non-availability of seats for students of this UT would result in shortage of doctors and may adversely affect the basic health care provisions in the UT of Pondicherry.
11. Doctor -patient ratio proposed to be achieved.	The same ratio can be maintained vis-avis the population growth and also ensure for functioning the health services available.

Sri Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai has applied for establishment of Medical College at Pondicherry. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Pondicherry has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Medical College with an annual intake of 150 seats.

It is certified that:-

(a) The applicant owns and manages a 300 bedded hospital which was established in August 2005

(b) It is desirable to establish a Medical College in the public interest.

(c) Establishment of a Medical College at Pondicherry by Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai is feasible.

(d) A reasonably equipped clinical laboratory for performing essential investigations, an X-Ray unit and a hospital Pharmacy are adequately supporting the requirements of the In-patients and Out-patients. It is further certified that it is not possible for this U.T. Administration to take over the responsibility of students already admitted in the Medical College with the approval of the Central Government in case the applicant fails to create the infrastructure for the medical college as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government.





4. And whereas, the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras had by an order dated 02.05.2007 directed the Union of India to consider and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law;





  - (b) The movable as well as immovable assets of the SLNIMS should also come under the total control of the 'deemed-to-be-university' Institute in order to protect the future of students, faculty, employees and interests of standards of higher education.
  - (c) The BIHER and its constituent institutions shall start/offer, as the case may, the courses/programmes only in accordance with the relevant prescribed norms and guidelines of the UGC and the relevant statutory professional regulatory Councils, such as Medical Council of India(MCI), Indian Nursing Council(INC), Dental Council of India(DCI), AICTE, etc.
  - (d) The BIHER or its constituent institutions shall not offer/award, as the case may be, any degrees that are not specified by the UGC. The BIHER will continue to ensure that the nomenclature of the degrees awarded by it are specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.
  - (e) BIHER shall award degrees in respect of the courses run by SLNIMS only to those students who are admitted/enrolled with SLNIMS subsequent to the date of this notification.
  - (f) BIHER shall regularly obtain the requisite 'renewal' of approval / permission of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and other relevant Statutory Councils, as the case may be, well within the prescribed time limit, for running of SLNIMS and in respect of its course(s) and intake capacity of students, etc.
  - (g) The 'deemed-to-be-university' shall suitably modify/amend its Memorandum of Association (MoA) and Rules and finalise them in conformity with the University Grants Commission's Model MoA and Rules for the Deemed to be Universities, after the inclusion of this institution, on a priority basis.
  - (h) The conditions stipulated in the Ministry's Notification No.F.9-5/2000-U.3 dated the 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2007 will continue to be in force and complied with.
