
In continuation of this Ministry's letter of intent of even number dated 20th March, 2006 and with reference to your letter dated 24th March 2006, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government to the establishment of a new medical college in the name and style of "Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences" at Pondicherry by Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai with an annual intake of 150 (one hundred and fifty only) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2006-07 under Section 10 (A) of IMC Act, 1956 as amended.

2. This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of the college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

3. This permission is subject to the Bank Guarantee of Rs. 9.50 crores (Rupees 2.00 crores towards medical college and 7.50 crores towards hospital facilities) furnished by Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai for the establishment of medical college and hospital found to be adequate/genuine on all counts. The admission process for the academic year 2006-07 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended.



Sri Lakshmi Ammal Educational Trust, Chennai has applied for establishment of Medical College at Pondicherry. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Pondicherry has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate to the applicant for the establishment of a Medical College with an annual intake of 150 seats.

It is certified that:-


(a) The applicant owns and manages a 300 bedded hospital which was established in August 2005

(d) A reasonably equipped clinical laboratory for performing essential investigations, an X-Ray unit and a hospital Pharmacy are adequately supporting the requirements of the In-patients and Out-patients. It is further certified that it is not possible for this U.T. Administration to take over the responsibility of students already admitted in the Medical College with the approval of the Central Government in case the applicant fails to create the infrastructure for the medical college as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government.

Whereas the Central Government had declared Bharath Institute of Higher Education & Research (BIHER), Chennai, comprising 'Sree Balaji Dental College and Hospital', Chennai, as deemed-to-be-university under the meaning of Section 3 of the University Grants Commission (UGC) Act, 1956 vide this Ministry's notification No.F.9-5/2000-U.3 dated the 4th July, 2002, subject to a review after five years.

2. And whereas, vide notifications of this Ministry listed below the Central Government had allowed the inclusion of certain other institutions under the same management in the ambit of the said 'Bharath Institute of Higher Education & Research' as indicated below against each notification:

And whereas, on the basis of a review of the functioning of the BIHER and its constituent institutions carried out by the UGC through an Expert Committee constituted for this purpose, and on the basis of its recommendation thereof, the Central Government, accorded approval to the continuance of the status of 'Deemed-to-be-University' granted to "BIHER", Chennai, comprising the teaching institutions which were its constituent units at that point of time, vide this Ministry's notification No.F.9-5/2000-U.3, dated the 11th January, 2007.


4. And whereas, the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras had by an order dated 02.05.2007 directed the Union of India to consider and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law;

 - (a) The management of Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences (SLNIMS), Puducherry and the Bharath Institute of Higher Education & Research (BIHER), Deemed-to-be-University, Chennai must be the same.
 - (b) The movable as well as immovable assets of the SLNIMS should also come under the total control of the 'deemed-to-be-university' Institute in order to protect the future of students, faculty, employees and interests of standards of higher education.
 - (c) The BIHER and its constituent institutions shall start/offer, as the case may, the courses/programmes only in accordance with the relevant prescribed norms and guidelines of the UGC and the relevant statutory professional regulatory Councils, such as Medical Council of India(MCI), Indian Nursing Council(INC), Dental Council of India(DCI), AICTE, etc.
 - (d) The BIHER or its constituent institutions shall not offer/award, as the case may be, any degrees that are not specified by the UGC. The BIHER will continue to ensure that the nomenclature of the degrees awarded by it are specified by the UGC under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.
 - (e) BIHER shall award degrees in respect of the courses run by SLNIMS only to those students who are admitted/enrolled with SLNIMS subsequent to the date of this notification.
 - (f) BIHER shall regularly obtain the requisite 'renewal' of approval / permission of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and other relevant Statutory Councils, as the case may be, well within the prescribed time limit, for running of SLNIMS and in respect of its course(s) and intake capacity of students, etc.
 - (g) The 'deemed-to-be-university' shall suitably modify/amend its Memorandum of Association (MoA) and Rules and finalise them in conformity with the University Grants Commission's Model MoA and Rules for the Deemed to be Universities, after the inclusion of this institution, on a priority basis.
 - (h) The conditions stipulated in the Ministry's Notification No.F.9-5/2000-U.3 dated the 11th January, 2007 will continue to be in force and complied with.



- (i) The 'Deemed-to-be-University' as well as all its constituent institutions shall continue to strictly abide by the norms and guidelines as laid down by the UGC and other statutory professional regulatory Councils such as, MCI, INC, DCI, AICTE, etc. from time to time, as are applicable to 'Deemed-to-be-Universities'.

Subject: Consideration of Compliance Verification Assessment report with regard to continuance of recognition of MBBS degree (150 seats) granted by Bharat University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to inform that the compliance verification assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree granted by Bharat University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry was carried out by the Council assessors' on 16.05.2017. The said assessment report alongwith previous assessment reports (25.07.2016 & 9th & 10th May, 2016) was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 11th July, 2017 and it was decided as under:-

“The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification assessment report 16.05.2017 alongwith previous assessment reports (25.07.2016 & 9th & 10th May, 2016) and decided to revoke the decision of application of clause 8(3)(1)(c) of Establishment of Medical College Regulation (Amendment), 2010 (Part-II), dated 16th April, 2010.

The Executive Committee further recommended that recognition of MBBS degree granted by Bharat University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Sri Lakshmi Narayana Institute of Medical Sciences, Puducherry be continued restricting the number of admission to 150 (One Hundred Fifty) students.

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16th April, 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8 (3) ...

- (2) *The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*
- (3) *The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.*
- (4) *Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute.”*

It is further to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material etc. throughout, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration of fabricated documents have been used for procuring the approval of Continuation of recognition by the Council and the said

misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage, your institution is liable not to be considered for approval of continuation of recognition with the annual intake capacity of 150 students and this approval is also liable to be revoked. Besides, MCI is entitled to take all such measures against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.




